



That JARED TYLER BAUGUS did on or about SEPTEMBER 10, 2025, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, knowingly or intentionally flee from DEPUTY DANIEL THOMAS, CARROLL COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, while operating a motor vehicle on a street, road, alley and/or highway in Carroll County, after having received a signal from DEPUTY THOMAS to bring the vehicle to a stop, and his flight or attempt to elude created a risk of death or injury to innocent bystanders or other third parties, all constituting the offense of EVADING ARREST, in violation of T.C.A. §§39-16-603(b)(1) and 39-16-603(d)(2)(B), a CLASS D FELONY, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of CARROLL, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That JARED TYLER BAUGUS did on or about SEPTEMBER 10, 2025, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, intentionally or knowingly, drive a motor vehicle over and along the public roads, streets and/or highways in CARROLL COUNTY, TENNESSEE; said vehicle was not equipped with an ignition interlock device as was ordered by the Court (Benton County General Sessions Court Case No. 24CR475) and which is a condition of Jared Tyler Baugus' driving privileges, thereby committing the offense of VIOLATION OF LAW REGARDING IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE, in violation of T.C.A. §55-10-417(h)(2), a CLASS A MISDEMEANOR, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
