



NINTH COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of CARROLL, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That JONATHAN RAY SULLIVAN did on or about NOVEMBER 15, 2024, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, knowingly or intentionally escape from The Hope Center (a long-term residential substance abuse facility) located in McEwen, Tennessee, where he had been in treatment since on or about November 6, 2024, pursuant to an Order Granting Furlough for Alcohol and Drug Treatment in the matter of State of Tennessee v. Jonathan Sullivan, Carroll County General Sessions Case No. 24CR1269 [Cout 1 (Aggravated Burglary), Count 2 (Burglary of a Vehicle), and Count 3 (Theft of Property)]; on or about November 15, 2024, the said Jonathan Ray Sullivan was dismissed from the Program for a failed drug screen, and after the dismissal he left The Hope Center and failed to return to the custody of the Carroll County Sheriff's Office, thereby committing the offense of ESCAPE, in violation of T.C.A. §39-16-605(a), a CLASS E FELONY, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
