



FIRST COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Carroll, upon their oath present:

That LARRY JOE LOGAN, on or about NOVEMBER 30, 2024, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, then and there did willfully drive, or was in physical control of an automobile, specifically, A 2015 JEEP WRANGLER, along, over and upon a public street, road highway or public thoroughfare, being HIGHWAY 79 AND GREENHILL ROAD, ATWOOD, TENNESSEE, while under the influence of any intoxicant, marijuana, controlled substance, controlled substance analogue, drug substance affecting the central nervous system, or combination thereof, that impaired the said LARRY JOE LOGAN'S ability to safely operate a motor vehicle, by depriving him of the clearness of mind and control of himself which he would otherwise possess, thereby committing the offense of DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN INTOXICANT OR DRUG, in violation of T.C.A. §55-10-401(1), A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

SECOND COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Carroll, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That LARRY JOE LOGAN, did on or about FEBRUARY 16, 2025, after having been involved in an accident, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, knowingly or intentionally fail to stop his vehicle at the scene of the accident or as close to the scene of the accident as possible, or to return to and remain at the scene of the accident, in which damage was done to vehicles or property not owned or operated by the said LARRY JOE LOGAN; said damages being in an amount that did not exceed one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) or would appear to a reasonable person not to exceed one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500), thereby committing the offense of LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT, in violation of T.C.A. §55-10-102(a), A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
