

THIRD COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Carroll, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That STEPHEN BRENT MOFFLER, during a period of time from JULY 27, 2025 through AUGUST 2, 2025, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, then and there did knowingly and repeatedly have unconsented contact with [REDACTED] via text messaging, and said actions did cause her to feel terrorized, frightened, intimidated, threatened, harassed, or molested. Further, at the time of the offense, the said STEPHEN BRENT MOFFLER had a prior conviction of Aggravated Stalking involving [REDACTED] the same victim in this offense (Carroll County Circuit Court Case No. 24CR170, Count 1, entered on September 19, 2024), thereby committing the offense of ESPECIALLY AGGRAVATED STALKING, in violation of T.C.A. §39-17-315(d)(1)(A), A CLASS C FELONY, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
